

2020 TRADES & TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

Details

This year, six (6) \$1,500 scholarships will be available to female students enrolling in one of the following programs to commence in September 2020:

Trades:

- Welder
- Carpenter
- Machinist
- Powerline Technician
- Heavy Duty Equipment Technician
- Construction/Industrial Electrician
- Industrial Mechanic (Millwright)

Technology:

- Civil Engineering Technology
- Electrical Engineering Technology
- Electronics Systems Engineering Technology
- Power Engineering Technology
- Instrumentation & Controls Engineering Technology
- Mechanical Engineering Technology
- Chemical Control Engineering Technology

If you are not accepted for one of the programs listed above, you will not be eligible for a scholarship.

Eligibility

Recipients must prove acceptance into a program, listed above, from a post-secondary institution of choice.

Applicants must be entering their first year in one of the programs listed above.

Applicants must be permanent residents of Newfoundland and Labrador.

Applicants must demonstrate skills relating to teamwork, communication, leadership, dignity, and respect.

Preference may be given to students who demonstrate financial need.

- ✓ Written essay (max 500 words) or video essay (max 4 minutes) - telling us why you deserve a scholarship
- ✓ Reference letters (2 max)
